
Spain Experience –Wine and Olive Oil!

Nutrition Course Credit




Counts as graduate course elective – take it during your undergraduate to pay undergraduate tuition!

Program Costs

Approx \$3000 per person*

*Based on a realistic estimate of participants. Fees may change based on final enrollment and/or currency fluctuation rates.

*Financial aid may apply.

• Costs include:

- Housing with Spanish family
- 3 meals/day Sunday night through Friday morning
- Laundry once a week
- All travel within Spain as outlined in schedule
- Cultural site admission costs as outlined in schedule
- International health insurance
