Straight Talk about the Wisconsin Elections Process

The State of Wisconsin has had a solid track record for managing national, state and local elections fairly. Nonetheless, there has been much discussion about the 2020 election results. Recounts in Madison and Milwaukee, and a voting analysis by the conservative law firm Wisconsin Institute for Law and Liberty all affirmed the results. Still, some citizens continue to have questions about the 2020 election results.

This program will be a conversational review of the key elements in the Wisconsin elections process, including dialogue regarding the practices and safeguards of some of the key points in question.

Meagan Wolfe was unanimously confirmed by the Wisconsin Senate in 2019 to serve as the Administrator of the bipartisan Wisconsin Elections Commission. She served as Interim Administrator beginning in March of 2018, during Scott Walker's term as governor. Meagan joined state service in 2011 as a Voter Services Election Specialist. Recognized as a champion for election integrity in Wisconsin, she has conducted countless presentations on the Wisconsin electoral process, the Photo ID law and other registration rules and processes.
