Dublin 3 nights, Armagh 2 nights, Galway 3 nights, Killarney 2 nights

Must be able to walk a couple of miles daily and be able to navigate some uneven surfaces

TUESDAY, OCT. 21

- Arrive into [Dublin Airport](#)
- Hotel and settle into rooms
- Lunch
- Presentation: “Celtic and Franciscan Spiritualities” – Fr. Francis Cotter, OFM
- Visit to [Trinity College Dublin](#) to see the [Book of Kells](#)
- Walk through part of the city around Trinity College or hop on/hop off bus tour of Dublin.
- Dinner and social

WEDNESDAY, OCT. 22

- Breakfast and prayer (early start)
- Visit historic [Newgrange](#) and the Hill of Slane where St. Patrick lit the first Easter fire; Service of Light in the old Franciscan friary there
- Drive into northern Ireland and visit [Holy Cross Abbey, Rostrevor](#)
- Mass with the monastic community
- Lunch
- Presentation: “The Legacy of St. Patrick” – Monks of Holy Cross
- Visit [Downpatrick](#), burial place of St. Patrick
- Stay overnight in [Armagh](#), the city of St. Patrick

THURSDAY, OCT. 23

- Breakfast
- Mass at [Armagh Cathedral](#)
- Lunch on your own at [Enniskillen](#)
- Continue to the holy island, [Lough Derg](#) by boat
- Overnight – invitation to fast and pray where St. Patrick did penance

FRIDAY, OCT. 24

- Prayer
- Fast is broken only after leaving the island, as is the custom
- Breakfast/lunch in [Donegal Town](#)
- Brief visit to the ancient ruins of the Franciscan Friary and the [O'Donnell Castle](#); the O'Donnell's were the Princes of Donegal and patrons of the Franciscan Friars before the Reformation
- Continue to the [National Shrine to the Blessed Mother](#) at Knock
- Mass in the Chapel of the Apparition
- Time to visit the basilica and break for a snack
- Continue to [Galway](#)
- Settle into hotel
- Dinner

SATURDAY, OCT. 25

- Breakfast and prayer
- Presentation: “Franciscan Ireland” – Br. Colman Clabby, OSB
- Mass with the [Poor Clares](#) in the monastery chapel followed by a visit with the community
- Lunch on your own in Galway and free time in the old city
- Visit to [Ennis Friary](#) and guided tour
- Return to Galway for dinner and time to relax

SUNDAY, OCT. 26

- Breakfast and Mass
- Tour of the [Burren](#), visiting the ancient Celtic and Christian holy sites
- Visit the [Cliffs of Moher](#)
- Lunch
- Return to Galway
- Encounter with Friars and YouFra (Young Lay Franciscans) at Galway Pastoral Centre – time for reflection and faith sharing
- Buffet supper and social

- Depart for [Killarney](#)
- Visit [Muckross Abbey](#) by the [Lakes of Killarney](#)
- Mass at the abbey (weather permitting)
- Tour Muckross Park
- Lunch at [Muckross House](#)
- Settle into hotel
- Visit the Franciscan Friary and meet the friars at the [Interprovincial Novitiate](#)
- Presentation: “Celtic and Franciscan Prayer” – Br. Patrick Lynch, OFM
- Evening free in Killarney and dinner on your own

- Visit the [Ring of Kerry](#) with guide, stopping in various places of interest en route
- Lunch
- Return to Killarney
