Eligibility Guidelines

The Scholarship:

- 1. Is awarded to one or more students who have been active with the Girl Scouts of WI Badgerland Council.
- 2. Can be applied toward tuition and fees for a Viterbo University student.

The Recipient:

- 1. MUST have been a resident for at least two (2) years in specific counties located in the geographic boundary of the Girl Scouts of WI Badgerland Council. Those counties include: Buffalo, Trempealeau, Jackson, La Crosse, Monroe, Juneau, Vernon, Richland, Sauk, Columbia, Dodge, Crawford, Iowa, Dane, Jefferson, Grant, Lafayette, Green, Rock, and Walworth counties in Wisconsin, Houston County in Minnesota and Allamakee County in Iowa.
- 2. Recipients must submit with their application verification of their active status within the Girl Scouts of WI Badgerland.
- 3. MUST file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with Viterbo University for the year(s) you hope to receive and utilize the scholarship.
